### NOTIFICATION

No. MISC. 2015/CR No. 252/TE-4.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (r) of section 2 read with sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 3 of the Maharashtra Un-aided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fees) Ordinance, 2015 ( Mah. Ord. No. VII of 2015), the Government of Maharashtra hereby declares and notifies the educational courses of study mentioned in column (2) of the schedule appended hereto shall be the Professional Education and specifies that the conditions and the requirements for admissions mentioned in respect of such course, in column (3) of the schedule shall be the eligibility conditions and requirements, therefor.
